(Literally: “upon the desolation”)

THE ANTICHRIST IS THE ONE WHO STOPS THE SACRIFICES IN BOTH DANIEL 9 AND DANIEL 11

FROM DANIEL 11 - KJV

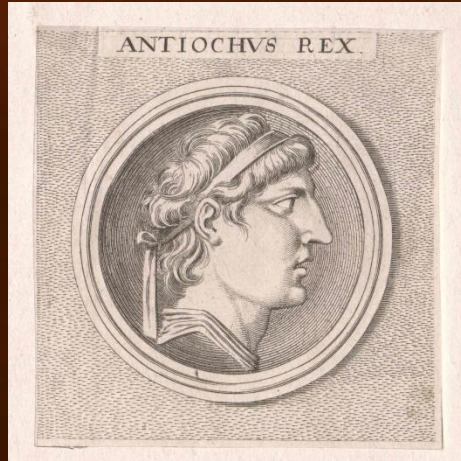
“And in his estate shall stand up a vile person, to whom they shall not give the honour of the kingdom...”

“And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.”

FROM DANIEL 9 - A LITERAL TRANSLATION

“he will cause to cease sacrifice and offering. And on a wing of abominations is one who makes desolate, even until a full end. And that which is determined will be poured out over the desolation.”

THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION WAS NOT FULFILLED BY ANTIOCHUS
